All potential designs include lowering elevated lanes and adding bike/ ped improvements.



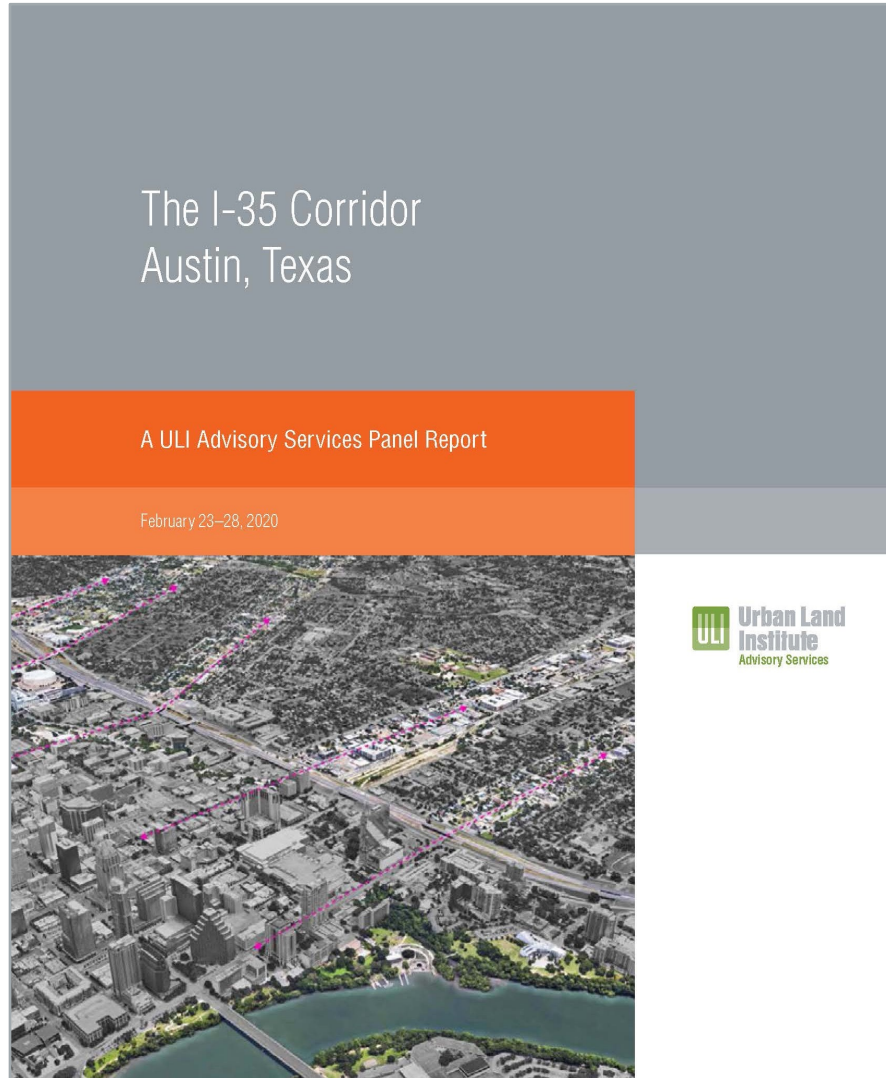

ULI ENGAGEMENT & RECOMMENDATIONS



11 acres of proposed caps (3 locations)

- + 5.3 acres: Cesar Chavez to 4th Street
- + 2.8 acres: 6th to 8th Street
- + 2.4 acres: 11th to 12th Street

City/TxDOT Coordination Update:

- All ULI recommended cap locations
- + Caps at 4th to 6th Street, Airport Blvd
- + Stitches included in CapEx Central (multiple crossings)

DALLAS KLYDE WARREN CAP PARK PROJECT



Spans the 8-lane, sunken
Woodall Rogers Freeway

Bridges Dallas' Uptown and
Arts District neighborhoods

Added 1/2 mile of walkable
streetscapes and 9 crosswalks

Creates sense of place

Provides amenities for all

COLLABORATION

TxDOT

- Accommodate construction of caps (deck plazas) and stitches in feasible locations
- Obtain environmental clearance for improvements
- Coordinate funding mechanisms with city



CITY OF AUSTIN

- Determine locations
- Design enhancements based on community input
- Meet regulatory compliance
- Provide total project cost estimate
- Coordinate funding



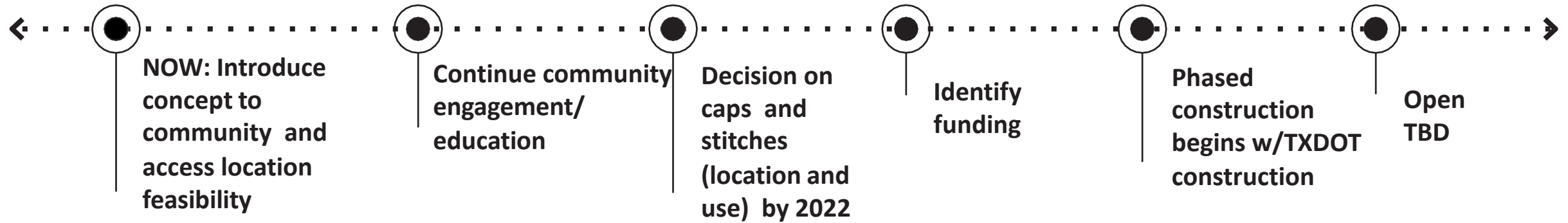
DOWNTOWN AUSTIN ALLIANCE
